

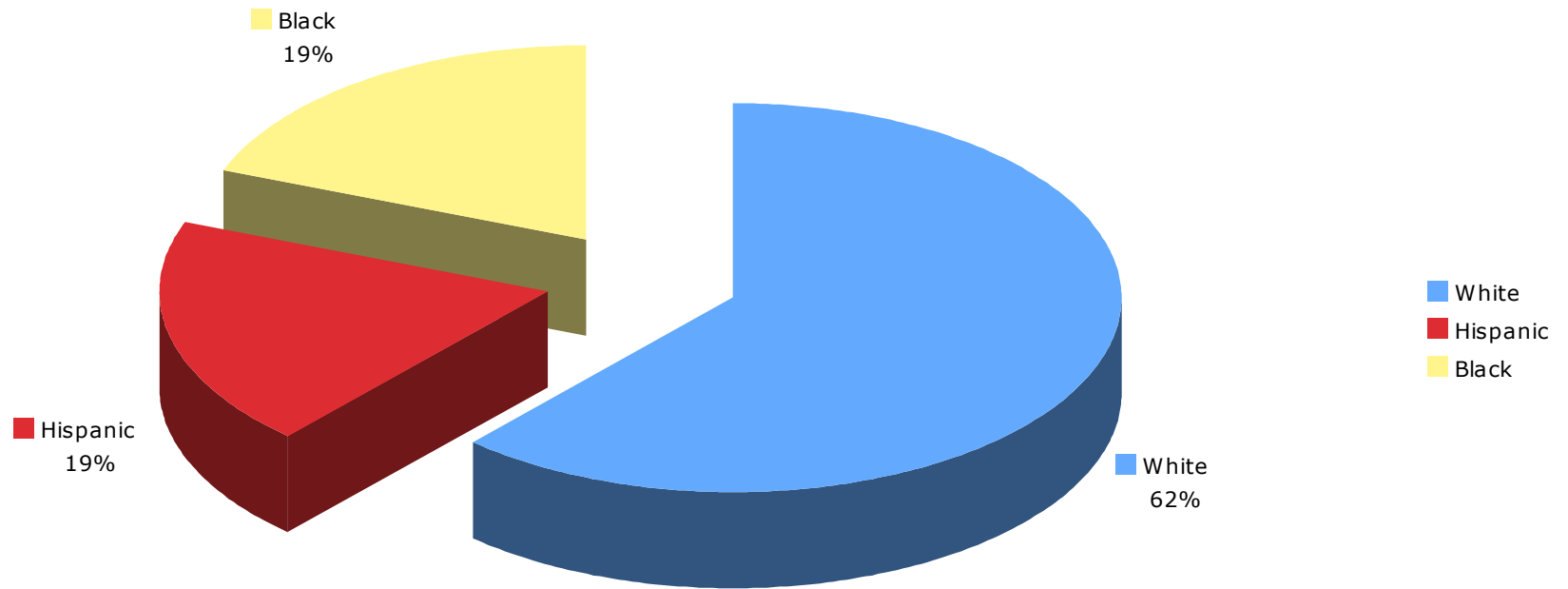

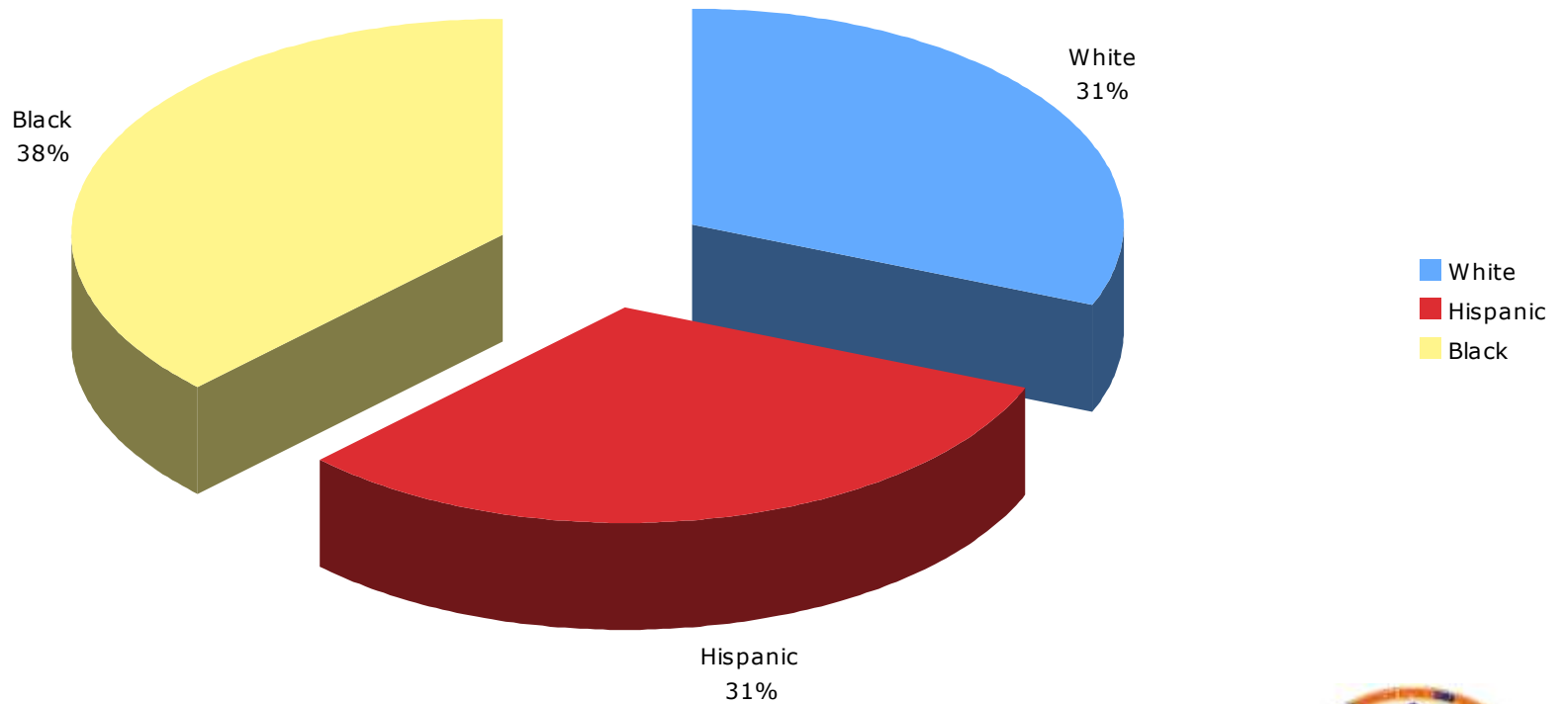


NJ K-12 Enrollment

NJ Dropouts 2004

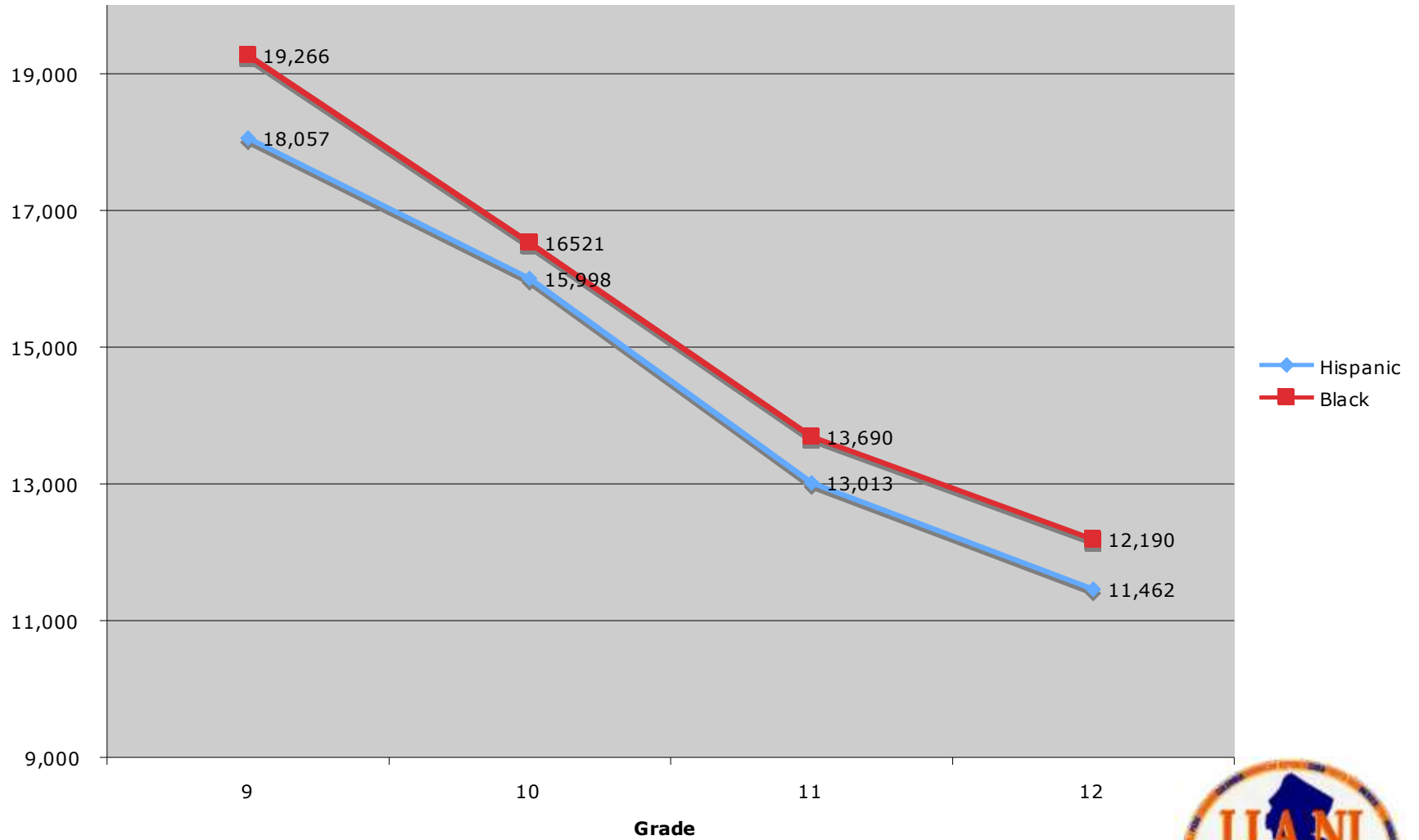

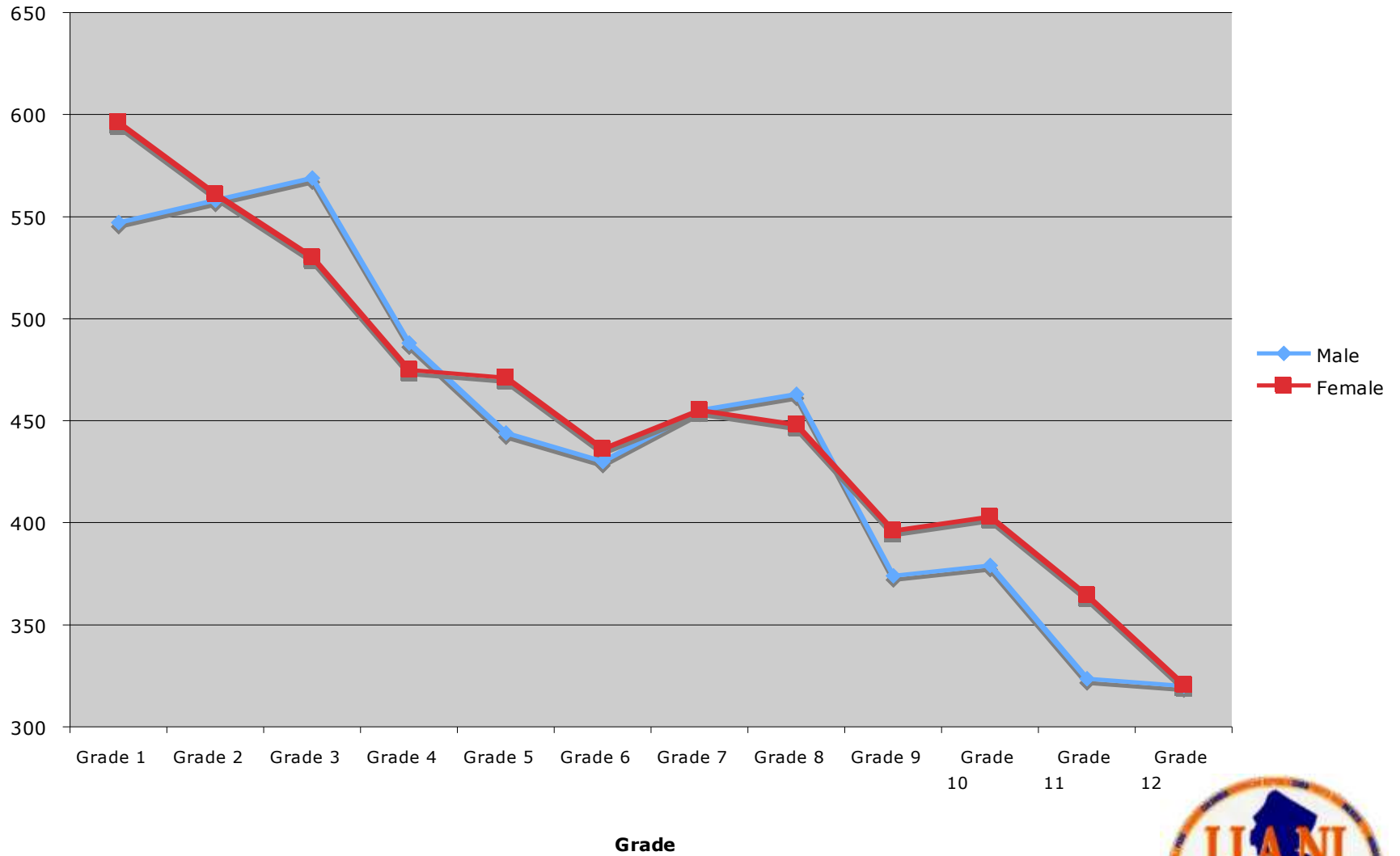
- 41,854 Students Total

- 2005: \$916,000,000 Public Education Expenditure



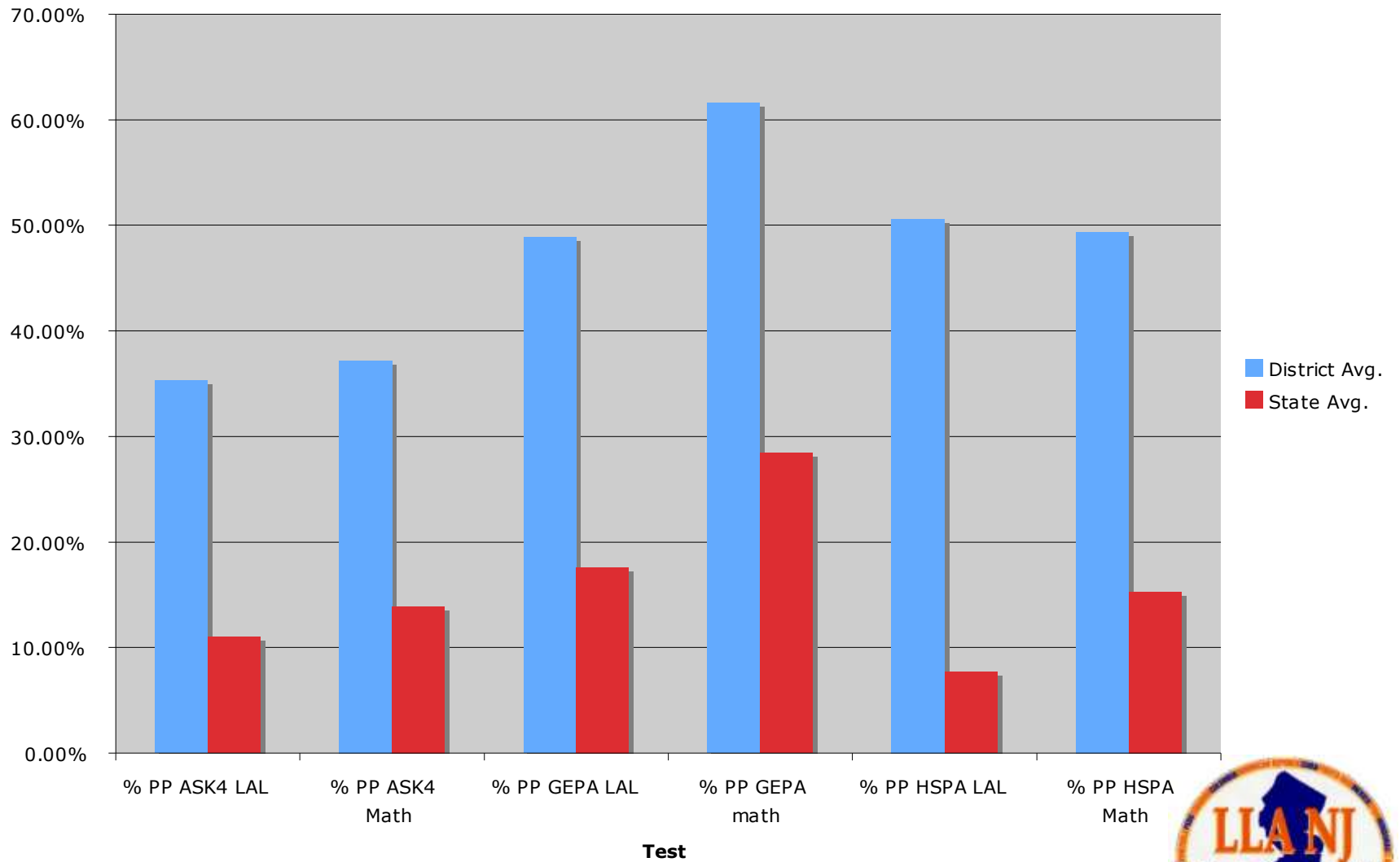
Statewide Enrollment Trends 2004 Snapshot



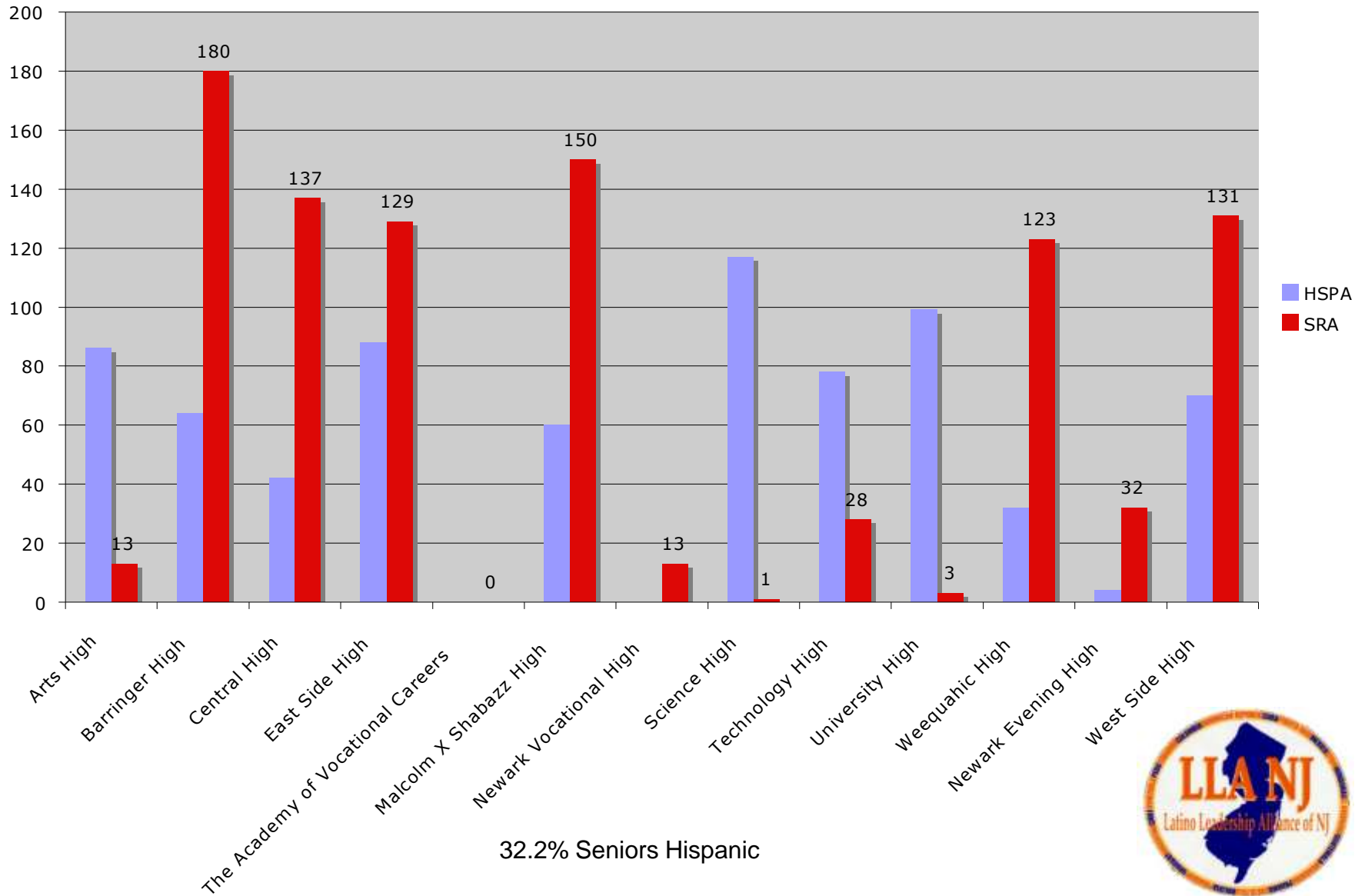
Hispanic Enrollment Snapshot 05-06
